



Safe travel to school

By bus & train...

- Maintain social distancing at bus stops & train stations – 2m where possible
- Use contactless payment or a bus / train pass where possible
- Wash or sanitise hands before and after travel
- Try to sit or stand away from other passengers – if you cannot keep a 2m distance then reduce the risk by maintaining a 1m distance, and taking suitable precautions
- Travel side by side or behind other passengers, rather than facing them
- Avoid touching handrails, doors and windows
- It is mandatory to wear face coverings on buses and trains
- Face coverings can be disposable or washable and must be worn at all times when travelling
- Follow all instructions given by staff or on signs

By car...

- You should keep travel with people from outside your household to a minimum. If you have to travel with other groups, open the windows, wear face coverings and sit side by side or apart if possible
- Get dropped off a short distance from school to avoid crowding at the gates
- Arrange a pick up point away from the school gates for home-time
- Wash / sanitise hands before travel

On foot...

- Only walk to school with people from your own household
- Wash or sanitise your hands before you leave
- Maintain social distancing – 2m apart where possible
- Take care at crossings as people may try to group together

You will be responsible for the provision, safe keeping and disposal of face coverings worn on buses or trains. Bins and plastic bags will be available at school. Disposal bags should be sealed once used

All year 7-11 pupils will enter and exit the school site via the Gainsborough Avenue gate. Year 12 & 13 should enter via the 6th form gate

All staff will enter via the Ormonde Drive gate

Do not travel to school if you or anyone in your household has a persistent cough, high temperature or loss of taste or smell
