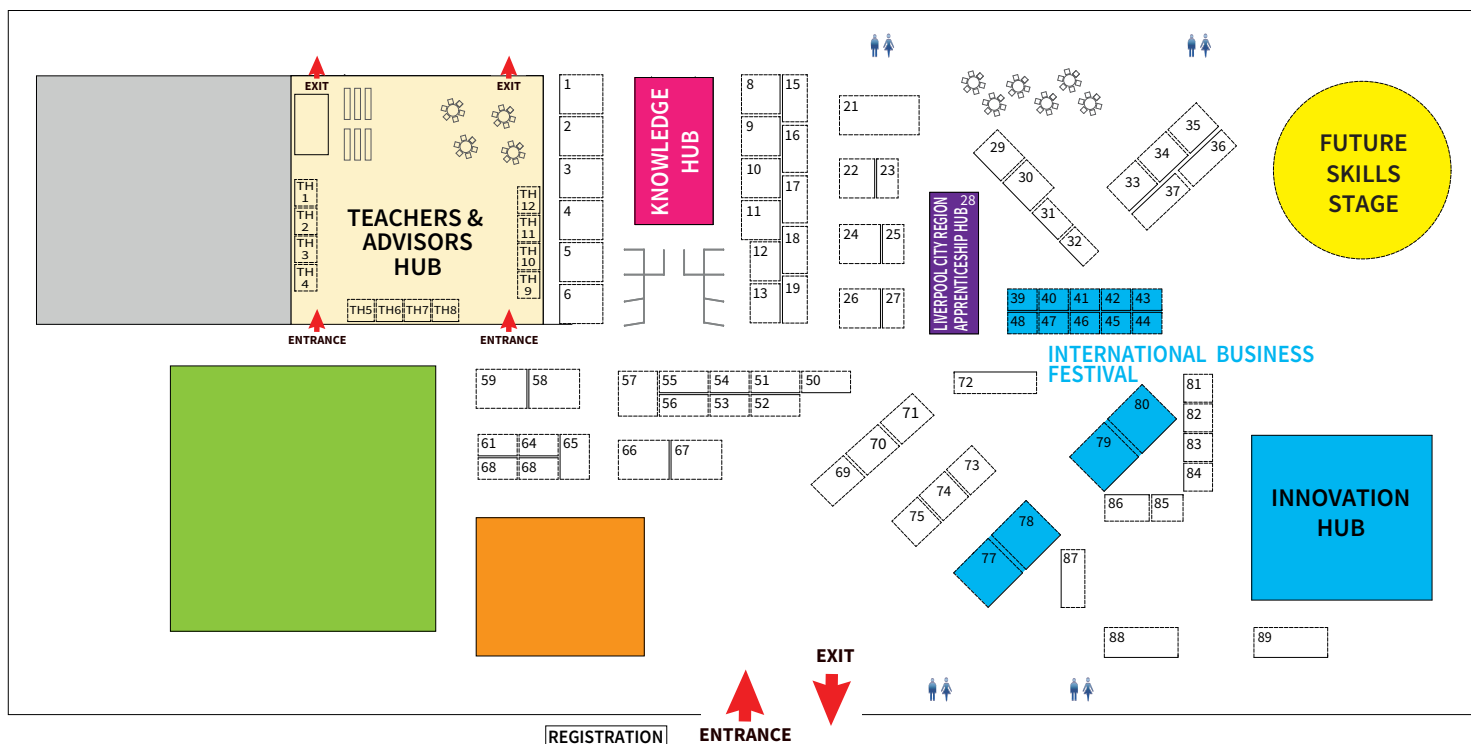

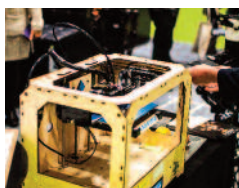
## Travel bursary
