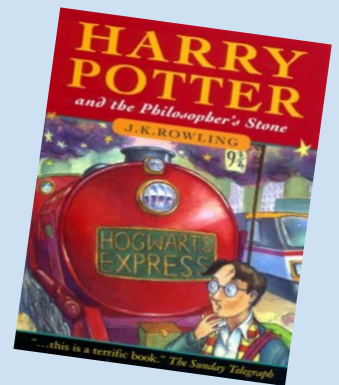
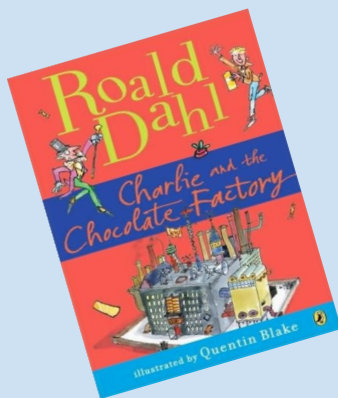


Welcome to the English Department

What you need to do

1. Write a detailed explanation as to why you enjoyed the book that has inspired your game. You may wish to think about the genre, plot, characters, the ending.
2. Provide an illustration (labelled) of your board game.
3. The pieces of your game should be characters from the book. Draw and give a brief description of each.
4. Write a clear set of instructions explaining how to play the game.
5. Your new board game will need to be advertised. Create a persuasive poster. You should include some persuasive text. Use some persuasive techniques (rhetorical questions, direct address, a slogan etc). Remember your target audience.
