



COVID-19 behaviour policy update for Maghull High School

Context

From 20 March 2020 parents were asked to keep their children at home, wherever possible, and for schools to remain open only for those children of workers critical to the COVID-19 response - who absolutely need to attend. Schools are now planning for the wider reopening to further pupils over the coming weeks and months. With this in mind, we have revisited our behaviour policy to ensure it supports our response to Covid-19.

COVID 19 Return to school expectations:

1. Enter the school site via Gainsborough gate
2. Line up outside the sports hall on floor markings
3. Walk on the left hand side of corridors following directional arrows
4. Observe two metre distancing when walking around the building or site
5. Sit in designated seat within classroom
6. Do not leave designated seat unless asked to by member of staff
7. Ask permission by raising hand if you do need to leave your seat
8. Queue as instructed by members of staff at lunchtime
9. Do not enter toilet if two people are already using the area and use designated toilets and wash basins
10. Behave maturely and sensibly at all times
11. Sanitise your hands as you enter and leave every room
12. Students should wash hands with soap and hot water throughout the day
13. Do not touch anyone else's belongings
14. Do not unnecessarily touch doors or other hard surfaces
15. Catch all coughs and sneezes in a tissue or crook of your elbow

Student equipment

Students should have a small bag that contains:

1. Phone
2. Tissues
3. Hand gel
4. Face covering (if required – two small plastic bags to store/dispose of face covering after use)
5. Water bottle

Additional items: (if appropriate)

1. Packed lunch
2. Latex gloves

Students are instructed not to bring any unnecessary additional items. The school will supply all stationary and other resources required.

Behaviour

Students will be sanctioned and may be required to leave the school site if they:

- Repeatedly fail to follow COVID 19 daily instructions by members of staff
- Do not conform to appropriate social distancing
- Cough or sneeze intentionally
- Compromise the safety of others through their actions
