We hope you are all well and look forward to welcoming your children back to school this week. Wednesday 1 September is our staff training day and students return as follows:

Friday 3 September: All students, 8.50am

Secondly, in line with guidance, we will be testing students for whom we have consent twice in their first week back at school. The details are below:

Thursday 2 September 2021 - Years 7 & 12

Friday 3 September 2021 - Years 11,10,9,8,13

Monday 6 September 2021 - Years 7 & 12

Tuesday 7 September 2021 - Years 11,10,9, 8, 13

If you would like to give consent for your child to be tested in school and have not already done so, please fill in the form on this link: <https://forms.gle/955tEAgLjhcTwm6W7>

It is recommended that parents continue to home test twice weekly until the end of September, at which point the government will review this recommendation. Those for whom we have consent will be provided with ten LFD test kits to use at home.

From 16 August, the policy on isolation changed and it is now the case that only students testing positive for Covid or those displaying symptoms must remain at home, where they will be provided with high quality remote education.
